Canada - Japan Academic Collaboration

Central to the spirit of Kwansei Gakuin is our motto 'Mastery for Service', which refers to a phrase used by the Canadian missionary of the Canadian Methodist Church and fourth chancellor, Dr. C.J.L. Bates, and the ties between Canada and Kwansei Gakuin began in 1910. Since 1980, over 50 faculty members from Canadian partner universities have been invited as Visiting Professors at KGU. The Annual Canadian Studies Seminar has been held since 1990 and later, in 1999, a permanent Professorship in Canadian Studies was also established. In 2014, KGU was awarded the prestigious grant 'Top Global University Project' by the Japanese government, to boost global competitiveness and increase student mobility. Since then, KGU has sent over 2000 students abroad annually, among those more than 500 students studying at Canadian partner institutions.

Representative Program of collaboration between Canada and KGU Cross-Cultural College



Cross-Cultural College (CCC) is unique in the way that:

It is a collaborative educational project jointly run by Mount Allison University, Queen's University, the University of Toronto and Kwansei Gakuin University. Established as a Japanese government-funded project, the program aims to educate students to become world citizens and leaders who can contribute to the growth and sustainability of a globalizing world with cross-cultural understanding and communication skills. Although this is a virtual college run by the four universities, CCC programs are also open to students from other designated KGU partner institutions.
